Branston Croquet Club has a legal duty to safeguard members and visitors to the Club. This will be fulfilled by a planned and systematic approach to identifying hazards, evaluating risk, and implementing appropriate control measures which will be kept under regular review.

HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

To support our Health and Safety policy statement we are committed to the following duties:

- Undertaking a regular, recorded risk assessment of the club premises and all activities undertaken by the club.
- Creating a safe environment by putting health and safety measures in place as identified by the assessment.
- Appointing a competent club member to assist with health and safety responsibilities.
- Ensuring that all members are aware of, understand and follow the club's health and safety policy and the guidance for safe play.
- Ensuring that normal operating procedures and emergency operating procedures are in place and known by all members.
- Providing access to adequate first aid facilities.
- Reporting any injuries or accidents sustained during any club activity or whilst on the club premises.
- Ensuring that the implementation of the policy is reviewed annually and monitored for effectiveness.

AS A CLUB MEMBER YOU HAVE A DUTY TO:

- Take reasonable care for your own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by what you do or not do.
- Co-operate with the club on health and safety issues.
- Correctly use all equipment provided by the club.
- Not interfere with or misuse anything provided for your health, safety or welfare.
